Mitsubishi Electric Announces Organizational Changes and Changes in Representative Executive Officers, Executive Officers, and Executive Officers (Associate) Effective April 1

TOKYO, **February 20**, **2025** – <u>Mitsubishi Electric Corporation</u> (TOKYO: 6503) announced today its organizational changes and changes in representative executive officers, the executive officer structure, and division of duties effective April 1, 2025, pursuant to a resolution passed during an extraordinary meeting of the Board of Directors held earlier today. The company also announced Executive Officers (Associate) to be appointed on the same date.

1. Organizational Changes (effective April 1, 2025)

(1) Establishment of Corporate Culture Transformation Division

Mitsubishi Electric intends to further penetrate its efforts and support self-directed initiatives to reform the Mitsubishi Electric Group's organizational culture from the perspective of its employees, which have been led mainly by the Corporate Transformation Group. For this purpose, the company will newly establish the Corporate Culture Transformation Division in the Sustainability Innovation Group by integrating functions of and measures for diversity, equity & inclusion (DE&I), well-being for employees, and the My Purpose Project¹, among others.

(2) Establishment of Corporate External Affairs Division

External relations activities including intelligence activities² related to economy and industry have become increasingly important with international situations getting complicated and laws and regulations enforced. Under these circumstances, Mitsubishi Electric intends to minimize risks and maximize business opportunities by gathering and analyzing such intelligence. For this purpose, the company will strengthen the roles and functions of the Government & External Relations Division, which currently belongs to the Corporate Legal & Risk Management Group, and form the Corporate External Affairs Division, reporting directly to the President.

(3) Renaming Corporate Advertising Division to Brand Communication Division

Mitsubishi Electric will rename the Corporate Advertising Division to the Brand Communication Division, to clarify its intention to strengthen branding initiatives such as brand governance³ and consistent messaging from a global perspective and to enhance its corporate value.

(4) Establishment of Corporate Procurement Group

Mitsubishi Electric will strengthen the roles and functions of the Corporate Purchasing Division and form the Corporate Procurement Group, with the intention to strengthen the supply chain of the entire Mitsubishi Electric Group and penetrate procurement governance and promote procurement activities with speed.

(5) Renaming Corporate Total Productivity Management Group to Corporate Manufacturing and Engineering Group, and Changing the Japanese Name of Corporate Research and Development Group

Mitsubishi Electric will integrate the development functions for engineering design technology, currently under the Corporate Research and Development Group, into the Corporate Total Productivity Management Group in order to strengthening *monozukuri* (manufacturing and engineering) technologies from manufacturing to services. The company will therefore rename the Corporate Total Productivity Management Group to the Corporate Manufacturing and Engineering Group, and change the Japanese name of the Corporate Research and Development Group, making it more relevant to the current English name. Going forward, the Corporate Research and Development Group will place more emphasis on research and development of technologies for future businesses.

(6) Changing the Japanese Name of Energy & Industrial Systems Group

Achieving carbon neutrality has become a major social challenge, and the Mitsubishi Electric Group has been making efforts toward expanding the introduction of decarbonized energy, developing technologies for the efficient use of energy, and providing energy management solutions. To better express its commitment to realize a sustainable society through such efforts, the company will change the Japanese name of the Energy & Industrial Systems Group, making it more relevant to the current English name.

(7) Establishment of Digital Innovation Group

To accelerate efforts towards achieving the Mitsubishi Electric Group's vision of becoming a "Circular Digital-Engineering Company," the company will reorganize the Business Platform Business Area and the IT Solution Business & Business Process Reengineering Group to newly form the Digital Innovation Group. The company will also incorporate the DX Innovation Center into the group to further accelerate its solutions businesses.
